

@NTBookshop Terms and Conditions *Hansard* Twitter competition

“National Theatre” means The Royal National Theatre situated at Upper Ground, London, SE1 9PX.

The National Theatre Bookshop is pleased to offer the opportunity to enter a prize draw, for one person to win a copy of the playtext of *Hansard* by Simon Woods, published by Faber & Faber, and one copy of the programme for the National Theatre’s production of *Hansard*.

- 1) Participants must be over the age of 18 years. Eligible participants will need access to the internet to enter the draw as all entries must be received through our website.
- 2) The competition opens at 4pm 4 September. The competition will close at midnight on Friday 6 September 2019.
- 3) To enter the competition, eligible participants will need to retweet the original @NTBookshop tweet between the time stated above.
- 4) The prize hamper consists of:
 - a) 1 x copy of *Hansard* by Simon Woods
 - b) 1 x copy of The National Theatre’s *Hansard* programme
- 5) The winner will be drawn on Friday 6 September 2019. Entries must be received by the National Theatre during the times stated in point (2).
- 6) The winner will be chosen at random by a computer generated process and the result of this decision will be final.
- 7) Prizes cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash.
- 8) The National Theatre reserves the right to request the winners to provide proof of identity, age and residency. The identification considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the National Theatre.

- 10) Winners will be notified on Twitter. If a winner does not claim their prize by Friday 13 September 2019, that prize will be forfeited and a new winner will be drawn.
